International Internship - Medicine

Our clinical rotations are planned together with the medical school coordinator and the International Department. Students should talk to their clinical advisor and the International team early on, since there are a few steps to follow before receiving the acceptance letter. International clinical rotations usually last between 4 and 16 weeks, and students can complete up to four rotations at UniEVANGÉLICA. They can also choose to do four-week rotations at different sites.

The following documents must be submitted:

- Study Plan
- Copy of Passport
- Academic Transcript
- Letter of Recommendation
- 3x4 cm Photo
- Vaccination Card

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Once accepted, students must submit the following documents:

- a) Student Visa
- b) Enrollment Certificate issued by the home institution
- c) The international student must obtain an international health insurance plan covering medical/dental care or a national health insurance plan covering medical/dental care upon arrival in Brazil.



Language Requirements

Most courses are offered in Portuguese.

International students have the opportunity to take free intensive Portuguese language classes at the institution.



Accommodation

Students can apply for accommodation at the International Student Residence, located near the campus. The prices refer to single apartments, but you can choose to share one, in which case each person will pay half the price.
