<a href="#">Pediatrics</a>	40 hours	2 weeks	5 Ects
All other units	20 hours	1 week	1 Ects

Please note that half the hours of internship of “Training Mix” will not be counted as half the ECTS, but the rule which will be applied is 20 hours = 1 ECTS. Example: 2 weeks (40 hours) of Internal Medicine is 2 ECTS, NOT 4 ECTS.
